Proof of Death certificates are provided to the deceased's authorized representative as a service only and are not a legal government document; however, they are usually accepted for most estate settlement purposes. Sometimes a provincial "Certified Death Certificate" will be necessary and is available for purchase from the Office of the Registrar General, or through us as a disbursement. \$250.00

Embalming is not legally required but may be recommended to preserve the body between the time of death and the visitation or disposition of the deceased. Disbursements

Disbursements are items arranged for and possibly paid for on your behalf by us. You are expected to pay for these items at the time the contract is entered. The following are some items that are often identified as disbursements. Coroner's fee – this is a fee charged by the coroner for issuing a certificate that allows cremation to take place. The fee is set by the Chief Coroner for Ontario. Clergy honorarium & Organist/Soloist/Piper honorarium – this is an amount paid to the clergy/organist/soloist/piper for their services. In some cases, the amount is set by the clergy/organist/soloist/piper, in others it is an amount to be determined by you. Newspaper or radio notices – these are charges for death notices placed in newspapers or radio or other media outlets. Municipal death registration fee – this is a fee charged by the local municipality to register the death. The fee is set by the municipality and may very. Grass & Device-equipment used for burial set-up at cemetery.

Payment, financing, and funding

Payment

Unless otherwise specified, payment is due within 30 days of signing the contract. Payment may be made by cash & cheque. Payment plans are also available to meet most budgets. Financing charges apply to payment plans. Beyond the allotted time, interest will be charged at a rate of 1.5% which is equivalent to 18% per annum (APR).

If you are prepaying for services or supplies, pre-authorized chequing is also available.

Financing

Our payment plans give you the option of making payments over time. We offer a competitive financing program, administration fees and interest rates.

Funding

For your convenience, we offer two funding options when prepaying services or supplies. When prepaying, you pay for the services and supplies today, and the money will be used to pay for the services and supplies when they are delivered at the time of death.
