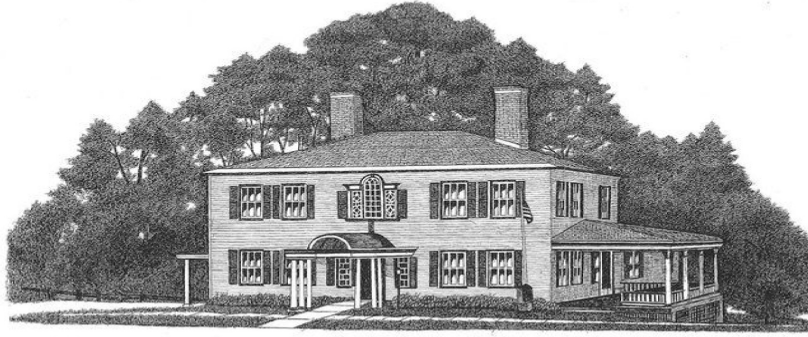

The goods and services included in this price list are those we can provide to our customers. You may choose only the items you desire. **However, any funeral arrangements you select will include a charge for our basic services and overhead.** If legal or other requirements mean you must buy any items you did not specifically ask for, we will explain the reason in writing on the statement we provide describing the funeral goods and services you selected. This list does not include prices for certain items that you may ask us to buy for you, such as cemetery, or crematory services, newspaper notices, or clergy and musician honorariums. The prices for those items will be shown on your bill or statement describing the funeral goods and services you selected. We do not charge you for our services in buying these items.

In order to be fair to all parties, discussion and agreement with regards to payment terms are handled at the time of an arrangement conference. As such, unless otherwise stated on the Funeral Goods & Services Selected that we provide at the conclusion of the arrangement conference, the following terms apply: all services, merchandise and cash advance items must be paid in full at the time a contract is executed. We are not permitted by law to extend credit of any kind, and we have many payment options available to you to meet these obligations.

We have never turned away a family based on their ability to pay and solicit your frankness regarding financial manners. We pledge to work with you, if necessary, to arrive at terms that are fair and amicable to all involved.

We accept many forms of payment including cash and check (*which do not incur a processing fee*) as well as all major credit cards (*2.99 % processing fee added to total amount*) and life insurance assignments (*up to 5 % processing fee of total amount being assigned, depending on insurance company or funding company.*)

GENERAL PRICE LIST

This price list is designed to familiarize you with the products and services that normally comprise different types of funeral arrangements. Our prices are presented in two formats: a complete itemized list of the goods and services that we offer, as well as packages that combine our most common services for burial and cremation, each containing different needs for facilities, equipment, and professional services.

The goods and services shown below are those we can provide to our families. You may choose only the items you desire. **However, any funeral arrangements you select will include a charge for our basic services and overhead.** If legal or other requirements mean you must buy any items you did not specifically ask for, we will explain the reason in writing on the statement we provide describing the funeral goods and services you selected.

PROFESSIONAL SERVICES

1. Basic Services of Funeral Director and Staff, and Overhead\$2,595.00

*Note: This non-declinable fee for basic services and overhead will be added to the total cost of the funeral arrangements you select. (This fee is already included in the charge of a direct cremation, immediate burial, and the charge of forwarding or receiving of remains). Our fee for the basic services of funeral director and staff includes, but is not limited to, staff to respond to the initial request for service; the arrangements conference with the family and responsible parties; arrangement of funerals; preparation and filing of necessary authorizations and permits; recording of vital statistics; preparation and placement of obituary notices; shelter of the remains; and coordination with those providing other portions of the funeral, e.g. cemetery, crematory, vault companies and others as required. Also included in this charge are overhead expenses relative to or facilities such as professional licensing, legal and accounting fees, insurance, building and utility expenses, parking lot and grounds, maintenance, taxes, equipment, furnishings, inventory cost, record keeping, and secretarial and administrative expenses.

2. Embalming\$ 650.00

Except in certain special cases, embalming is not required by law. Embalming may be necessary, however, if you select certain funeral arrangements such as a funeral with viewing. If you do not want embalming, you usually have the right to choose an arrangement that does not require you to pay for it, such as direct cremation or immediate burial. This service provides professional care and preparation of the deceased. Brady & Levesque Funeral Home's highly trained and exceptionally qualified staff are made available twenty four hours a day to cleanse, sanitize, embalm and prepare for viewing and/or other disposition of the body using modern, scientific methods to safely ensure public health, proper discharge of infectious materials, and contaminants. All procedures are in strict compliance with OSHA guidelines. **GREEN Embalming contains NO Formaldehyde and Natural Materials.**

3. Other Preparation of the Body

Preparation of the decedent when not being embalmed (sanitation, dressing, casketing and/or setting of facial features).....\$ 335.00

Dressing, casketing and/or cosmetology (when embalmed).....\$ 300.00

Post Autopsy Care (extra care required for autopsied decedents to be embalmed).....\$ 325.00

Restorative Art: Reconstruction when necessary.....\$ 100.00 per hour

Removal of pacemaker, defibrillator, or any other medical device, and proper disposition.....\$ 50.00

Refrigeration per day after the first 24 hours from the time of death.....\$ 50.00

Topical Disinfection Only for Direct Cremation.....\$ 30.00

Custodial care and storage of cremated remains (per month).....\$ 125.00

If for any reason, the cremated remains are held at our funeral home for any length of time with no arrangement for return to family or interment, this charge will be applied every month or portion thereof, commencing on the 7th day after cremation, unless prior arrangements have been made.

11. Forwarding to Another Funeral Home.....\$ 4,885.00 to \$ 4,145.00

This charge includes: The Basic Services of the Funeral Director and Staff, Transfer of the decedent from the place of death to our funeral home, Embalming, Necessary authorizations and a Service vehicle for transportation to a carrier. This does not include any rites or ceremonies.

With a minimum shipping container. (Container - \$ 550.00).....\$ 4,885.00

With a casket selected from our funeral home (in addition to the cost of the casket).....\$ 4,145.00

12. Receiving from Another Funeral Home.....\$ 3,315.00

This charge includes: The Basic Services of the Funeral Director and Staff, Transfer of the decedent from a local common carrier to our funeral home, and a Service vehicle for transportation to the burial location.

IMMEDIATE BURIAL

13. Immediate burial without a visitation or ceremonies available from.....\$ 4,570.00 to \$ 3,575.00

The charge of any immediate burial options includes the Basic Services of Funeral Director and Staff, Transfer of the decedent from the place of death to our funeral home, Sanitary care of the deceased, Refrigeration (up to 48 hours) and a Service vehicle for transportation to the burial location, All direct burials are scheduled according to the cemetery availability and are unwitnessed by the family. This charge does not include any cemetery fees, merchandise or ceremonies or services at our funeral home, or another facility. *Our Alternative Casket is the Danson Cardboard Casket - \$895.00

A .Immediate Burial with a container provided by the purchaser.....\$ 3,575.00

B .Immediate Burial with an alternative casket purchased from our funeral home.....\$ 4,570.00

DIRECT CREMATION

14. Direct Cremation without a visitation or ceremonies available from.....\$ 2,250.00 to \$ 2,140.00

Our charge for Direct Cremation (without ceremonies) includes: a portion of the Basic Services of Funeral Director and Staff, Transfer of the decedent from the place of death to our funeral home, Body Pouch required by the crematory, Transportation to and from the crematory, Necessary permits, and the Cremation fee. If you want to arrange a direct cremation, you can use an alternative container. Alternative containers encase the body and can be made of materials like fiberboard or composition materials (with or without an outside covering). The containers we provide range from fiberboard (heavy cardboard) to hardwood (pine and poplar). A complete list will be provided at the funeral home. Included in B. below is the Heavy Cardboard Container.

This charge includes a portion of the basic service of funeral director and staff, transfer of the remains from the place of death to our funeral home, and transfer of the remains to the appropriate medical school, (within a radius of 30 miles) and preparation and filing of necessary permits and certificates.

Our Green Service Options Include: Basic Services of Funeral Director and Staff, Local Removal of the Remains, Refrigeration (Maximum of 48 Hours), Sanitary Care for the Remains, Dressing and Casketing/Shrouding of the Body, any chosen Funeral Services, and Transportation to the Cemetery. (PRICES DO NOT INCLUDE CASH ADVANCES)

19. Aquamation

Aquamation or Alkaline Hydrolysis doesn't produce toxic gases or greenhouse gases. It also uses a fraction of the energy as flame cremation and avoids the use of fossil fuels. Aquamation expends 10% of the energy used in cremation, and it has a 75% lower carbon footprint than cremation.

- Direct Cremation with Aquamation.....\$3,230.00

The same as our Direct Cremation charge above, Transportation to the facility, and return of remains. Items NOT included are necessary permits and the cremation fee.
