MINIMUM SERVICES CREMATION, BURIAL OR HYDROLYSIS ONLY

The Minimum Service charge represents the minimum non-declinable services required to facilitate the disposition of a deceased person, whether by cremation, burial, or hydrolysis (also known as "aquamation").

This minimum service charge is applicable to every family we serve and includes transferring the deceased from the place of death (or Coroner's Office, hospital, airport etc.) to our holding room, where the deceased will be placed in a casket of your choosing and securely held until the necessary documentation is completed for burial, cremation, or hydrolysis, as applicable. Once the required documentation is ready (i.e. death has been registered and if applicable, the coroner's certificate for cremation / hydrolysis has been obtained), the deceased is transported in a service van to the cemetery, crematorium, or hydrolysis facility at the earliest practicable opportunity or at a scheduled time, as applicable.

Additional fees may apply for embalming preparation, mileage beyond 40 Km or pallbearers (burial only).

ADDITIONAL SERVICE OPTIONS

Heritage Funeral Centre offers the following services options:

Additional Body Preparation Services:

It is our policy that human remains be identified whenever possible prior to Minimum Service Options, cremation / hydrolysis, graveside services or in all situations where there is to be a closed casket. The identification may be made by anyone who knew the deceased, including a relative, friend, neighbour, co-worker, or clergy person. While identification of a body is possible with the minimum required preparation or essential care, you may wish to consider opting for basic embalming preparation or clinical care, as it might afford a more peaceful final viewing experience. Embalming is not legally required, but may be recommended to preserve the body between the time of death and final disposition. One of our funeral directors will be able to guide you on recommendations based on the condition of the body and the expected service needs.

Graveside Service:





This is a gathering of family and close friends at the cemetery graveside for a brief religious or non-religious committal service of the casket or urn at the grave.

Visitation:



These are informal gathering of periods that allow family and friends to come and pay their respects and offer comfort to a grieving family. It may create the opportunity to display personal items, mementos or to share a photo tribute to personalize the event and the life lived. Our suggested visitation times are from 4 - 8 pm. Visitation periods may be held as visitation periods on their own, or as part of, and generally prior to a Funeral Service or Memorial Service.

ADDITIONAL SERVICE OPTIONS Continued

Funeral Service:



This includes services, rites and ceremonies with the body present in a casket. A funeral service can be religious or non-denominational and can be held in various places, including our chapel, at a place of worship, or a venue such as a club or hall. A funeral service may also include a brief visitation period prior to the funeral service or it may include visitation the day before the service should you wish.

Memorial Service or a Celebration of Life:



This is a service to commemorate the deceased, which takes place after the body has been cremated or hydrolyzed. The cremated / hydrolyzed remains may or may not be present, as preferred by you; a framed portrait and personal mementos might also serve as a focal point during the memorial service at the location of your choosing with the option of visitation.

Receptions:



Throughout life, food has always played a large part in many family events, whether it was a wedding, a birthday, a retirement gathering or even a funeral. Sharing food, enjoying a meal together after a funeral or memorial service during these times brings comfort. It can also provide an ideal place to share memories and create an appropriate celebration. Our reception room is a convenient way for everyone to gather in one place without the stress of planning for the work of cleaning up after. We offer a large facility in which families may gather and receive guests. Our reception rooms accommodate 60 people. A hostess

is provided for the set-up of the reception, offering tea, coffee, and cold beverages.

SERVICE PACKAGE OPTIONS:

The Funeral Service Only onsite package represents all services in the Minimum Services charge, plus: one hour of visitation at the funeral home, followed by a funeral service on the same day in our chapel; embalming, dressing and basic hairdressing services, professional staff supervision and guidance throughout the visitation, funeral service and cemetery committal service. The use of a visitation suite including equipment to display personal items and floral tributes; the use of our facility for the funeral service. Following the funeral service, the deceased is transported in a funeral coach to the cemetery for a graveside burial service, or to the crematorium, or hydrolysis facility at the earliest practicable opportunity or at a scheduled time, as applicable. Once the cremation or hydrolysis is complete the remains are brought back into our funeral home care and the burial of the remains are co-ordinated with the family for the graveside burial of the remains in the urn selected by the family.

Once the cremation or hydrolysis is complete the remains are brought back into our funeral home care and the burial of the remains are co-ordinated with the family for the graveside burial of the remains in the urn selected by the family.

Professional consultation with licensed funeral personnel, which may include but is not limited to, planning and scheduling of services, drafting notices, web hosting of funeral details and online condolences.

Coordination of all contracted services before, during and after they have been provided by us, and those provided by third-party suppliers, such as cemetery, crematorium, florists, and media outlets (Death notices).

Documentation - Permits, Forms etc.

Completion and filing of all documents necessary to carry out the services and supplies requested, including, but not limited to, death registration, burial permit, coroner's certificate, clergy record where required, cremation application or interment permission form. Third-party fees charged for these documents are not included and are itemized as disbursements on page 16. We also provide 10 Proof of Death Certificates for estate settlement purposes. Proof of Death Certificates are provided to the deceased 's authorized representative as a service only and are not a legal government document; however, they are usually accepted for most estate settlement purposes. Sometimes a provincial "Certified Death Certificate" will be necessary and is available for purchase from the Office of the Registrar General, or through us as a disbursement.

The body is checked for personal effects (which will be returned to the authorized representative, unless otherwise instructed) and placed into the casket selected.

This service includes those described in "Minimum Preparation of Remains" above, plus bathing, dressing, and setting of facial features for Identification or viewing without embalming, basic hairdressing and cosmetics, if desired.

Embalming / Clinical Care of Remains

(Requires facilities for clinical care / preparation / shelter).

The embalming or Clinical Care is the process of replacing blood and body fluids with chemical preservatives. It is a process of sanitation, restoration, and temporary preservation. Embalming is not legally required, but may be recommended to preserve the remains between time of death, the visitation or disposition of the deceased. We will make a recommendation based on the condition of the remains and expected service needs. This service includes those described in "Basic Preparation of Remains" above.

DISBURSEMENTS

Disbursements are items arranged for and possibly paid for on your behalf by the funeral home to third party providers. Any prices quoted in this section are subject to change without notice. Such items include but are not limited to:

Interment fee: \$ Varies

This fee is charged by the cemetery for the opening and closing of the grave. Fee varies by the cemetery and by the size and depth of the grave.

Crematorium fee: \$ Varies

This fee is charged by the crematorium for the cremation of a body. The fee varies by crematorium.

Scattering Fees: \$ Varies

This fee is charged by the cemetery tor the administration and permissions to scatter on cemetery property. Fee varies by cemetery.

Coroner's fee: \$75

This is a provincially set fee charged by the coroner for issuing a certificate that allows cremation/alternative disposition or "Out of Province" repatriation to take place.

Municipal Death Registration: Toronto \$ 55

This is a fee charged by the local municipality to register the death on behalf of the Province of Ontario. The municipality issues a burial permit, then forwards the registration documents to the Office of the Registrar General in Thunder Bay, ON.

Clergy / Church / Celebrant / Musician Honorarium \$ Varies

This is an amount paid to the clergy, church, celebrant and/or musician for their services. In some cases, the amount is set by the third party, in others it is an amount to be determined by you.

Media Notices: \$ Varies

These are the at cost charges for the death notices to be placed in newspapers, or other media outlets.

Repatriation Airfare fees: \$ Varies

Fees charged by the airline by weight for shipping Human Remains.

Airport Handling fees: \$ Varies

Fees charged by the Airport Authority for handling Remains.

Certified Death Certificates from the Province of Ontario: \$52 each

Fees charged for Death Certificates provided by the Province of Ontario when needed in a rush for repatriation purposes.

Consulate fees: \$ Varies

Fees for the consulate to review and provide clearance documentation for repatriation.

The following caskets listed are those generally available. Additional options are available upon request. Unless otherwise noted, all caskets are standard adult size.

Minimum requirements for a casket:

<u>For Burial</u>: The least expensive wood casket is suitable and is required by most cemeteries' by-laws for interment, in the interest of the health and safety of the workers involved in the interment process. A metal casket may also be used for burial. A growing number of cemeteries in Ontario offer "green" burials which may consist of interment of a body without a casket. Since there is no legal definition for a "green" burial, it varies from one cemetery to another. For more information, please speak with one of our funeral directors, or visit www.greenburialcanada.ca.

<u>For Cremation:</u> A body must be presented to the crematorium in a rigid, leak proof casket that is made of a combustible material, such as wood or cardboard. Caskets containing non-flammable, hazardous material or chlorinated or fiber-reinforced plastic, other than incidental metal, cannot be used for cremation. We offer a selection of inexpensive caskets below that are suitable for cremation.

<u>For Hydrolysis:</u> A casket is not used for hydrolysis (also known as "aquamation". In some instances, a hydrolysable container or shroud may be required. For more information on this alternative method of disposition, please speak with one of our funeral directors, or refer to the <u>Bereavement Authority of Ontario's Consumer</u> Information Guide.






Outer burial containers listed below are for standard adult size caskets. Oversize vaults are available to accommodate plus-size caskets. Price includes local grave set up and lowering device. Some out-of-town cemeteries may have an additional charge for the grave set up and lowering device.



The purchase of a grave liner or a vault is an optional item, unless the Medical Officer of Health has made the



use of vaults and grave liners mandatory in the entire cemetery. A cemetery operator may designate a specific area in the cemetery where vaults or grave liners are required; however, the operator must have another area where vaults or grave liners are not required, so that consumers have a choice. A vault or grave liner may be recommended when there are environmental conditions such as poor drainage or aesthetic reasons.

A grave liner is an unlined concrete box with a lid. The base is placed into the grave, the casket is lowered into the base and the lid is then placed on top. A burial vault is constructed of reinforced concrete, which is often painted gold or silver and has an inner liner along with seal to make the burial vault resistant to the entrance of water and grave site substances.

Operating a modern cemetery requires heavy equipment such as backhoes and tractors. A strong durable vault provides greater protection from the weight of the equipment as well as the elements of the earth.


