THIRD PARTY FEES

These charges are for Graceful Hands Grave Service. If a cemetery requires use of their own company, grave charges will be subject to their fees (ex: perpetual care cemeteries).

This is a cash advance item and may be due at the time arrangements are made. (Cash or check to Graceful Hands Grave Service). Additional fees might include \$850 for oversize graves and \$250 per hour for rock break up at gravesites.

Obituaries in the local papers are placed according to the wishes of each family. The Gateway Beacon and Times GA range in price from \$40-\$100 each. Pictures can be included for \$35 per paper. They also have a "free" version, but only lists the name and service information. For most other newspapers, we will send the obituary in for a quote and check with you before we run it.

FLORIST

PAYMENT TERMS

We accept all major credit cards, cash, check, or money orders. All card transactions have a fee of 3.5%.

We will also be happy to file your life insurance for you with an assignment to pay for our services. This service has a fee of 4% of the contract total or a \$125 minimum.
