Our fee for the basic services of funeral director and staff includes, but is not limited to:

- Responding to the initial request for service, 24 hours per day, 365 days per year.
- Conducting the arrangement conference with the responsible party to determine desired services.
- Preparation of biographical and statistical data to complete transcripts of death, clergy record, social security notification, veterans applications.
- Examination of financial settlement options.
- Preparation and filing of papers, permits and authorizations.

- Coordination with those providing other services, such as clergy, cemetery, crematory, fraternal lodges, military, civic organizations and another other parties involved in the ceremonies, transportation and final disposition of the deceased.

If you do not want embalming, you usually have the right to choose an arrangement that does not require you to pay for it, such as direct cremation and immediate burial.

No human remains may remain unburied or uncremated in New Jersey for more than 48 hours unless embalmed or refrigerated (N.J.A.C. 8:9-1.1)
